Emergency Management activities include mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery related to any kind of disaster, whether natural, manmade or technological. *Emergency management* means being prepared for all kinds of emergencies, able to respond in time of crisis to save lives and property, to recover from the event in the shortest amount of time and to help the University return to normal activities after a disaster occurs.
